SOD & GRASS	Yellowstone applied fertilizer and weed control to the sod areas. Unfortunately, this will result in more brown areas in the sod. We will be getting quotes for sod replacement once we see the results of the weed control and soil tests. We are researching options for sod that is more drought tolerant and ground cover for behind villas.
IRRIGATION	Please do not change timers or turnoff the irrigation system. If there is an issue, notify the SRV Office.
TREES & PALMS	<p>Please do not install any additional trees or palms.</p> <p>Yellowstone will be trimming the trees with the red blooms in the front flower beds in March. We are requesting proposals from Arborists and Tree Trimming companies to address the Oaks and Palms.</p>
PLANTS & SHRUBS	<p>Please do not install new plants in the front of your villa without approval by SRV Office. We will be filling in areas in front of villas this year with new plantings.</p> <p>Owners are permitted to install plants in the flower beds on the sides and backs of villas and fence lines. Please only use plants on the "Approved Plant List" available on srvsarasota.com. and outside the Office door. Please do not create garden areas behind villas in the Common Areas.</p> <p>Yellowstone is removing dead plants/shrubs and trimming shrubs. If you do not want Yellowstone to trim plants, please place a visible red ribbon on the plants.</p>




