



Although Darlene, who originally organized the event, became ill, several individuals stepped forward — especially **Harriet Marek, Jeanne Schmidt, and Kathy Kelly**. Their teamwork and dedication ensured the luncheon was a success.

The event sold **45 tickets** and was essentially a break-even financially. However, the number of toys donated for boys and girls made the effort more than worthwhile. Thank you to everyone who attended, brought toys, and contributed homemade desserts. We continue striving to keep event costs low for residents.

Just like the clubhouse committee, the **Social Committee needs new volunteers**. Many events only happen because a handful of residents consistently step up. For example, our **New Year’s Eve Party** came together at the last minute thanks entirely to **Elaine Robichard and Danny Hooks**, as no one else had initially volunteered to host it.

We’ve already had great suggestions and new residents offering to host events next year, and we look forward to building on that energy. We hope many of you will join the Social Committee when we reorganize in early January.

## December 11, 2025, Annual Meeting Election Committee Report

This year SRV used a new electronic voting vendor — CondoVoter. Owners were quite pleased with how easy it is to access the voting system and cast their vote. To date, we have not received any negative comments about the new system. The Election Committee was able to obtain required reports and provide the voting results quicker than we have in many years, due in part to the reasons below.

- Monday, December 8, SRV had received barely enough ballots and online votes (177 total) to meet the quorum requirements (169). The Election Committee was able to do preliminary processing of the paper ballots which saved considerable time at the Annual Meeting. At SRV, the Limited Proxy/Meeting Ballot lists the item(s) being voted on, serves as your ballot, and is used to determine a quorum. Even if you attend the meeting in person, SRV is required to produce a record of your actual vote as proof of your vote and that a quorum was attained.
- SRV and CondoVoter sent reminders encouraging owners to vote.
- More owners e-voted than in recent years — 172 voted online (a new record!). Only 52 owners voted on paper. At least 224 Yes votes are required for amendments to pass. We still need more owners to vote! Note that on December 15, four days after the meeting, SRV received 4 ballots in the mail that were postmarked Dec. 8. Please allow extra time for mail delivery of ballots.
- Online voting closed at 9:00 a.m. Thursday, which gave the Committee time to start generating the CondoVoter reports needed to begin tallying totals of online and paper votes.
- CondoVoter created 3 separate voting portals for SRV to accommodate our need to report results by Section. This required running each report 3 times – once for each Section.
- We were able to print reports to indicate on the Master Register owners who e-voted and determine if anyone e-voted and paper voted. Two owners voted both paper and e-vote. Since their vote selections were the same online and paper – their paper ballot was marked Disregard and the reason was noted. Only their online vote was counted in the Tally. Both owners were informed. Remember each villa is allowed only 1 vote.

- Online voting closed at 9:00 a.m. CondoVoter's Summary Reports for each Section were generated shortly thereafter in a usable format — a major time saver over previous years.
- Because we had 5 candidates for the 5 vacant Board of Directors positions, an election of the directors was not required.

The Committee tallied the total votes — paper ballots plus e-votes, and the results were ready to report to the Meeting at 10:15! Quite an improvement over past years!

A detailed report of the voting results was emailed to owners later that afternoon. The proposed Consolidation of the three Sections did not pass (it required 2/3 Yes votes to pass). The Rollover passed (it required 51% Yes votes of those who voted).

The breakdown of owners who voted this year is below. We still need more owners to vote!




